Requirements for Admission to Early Childhood Degree Program?	<p>Steps for Admission to Programs of Study</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete and submit an application form. 2. Request a copy of your high school or GED transcript be sent directly to the College Admissions Office at the appropriate campus. High school or GED transcripts are not required if a student has completed and submitted an official transcript for an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. 3. Request copies of official transcripts from all postsecondary institutions be sent directly from the institution to the College Admissions Office at the appropriate campus. 4. Initial assessment: All students entering SCC programs must complete a basic skills assessment by at least one of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Appropriate ACT scores in each of the areas of language, reading, and math as required by specific program. b. Providing evidence of three hours or more of transfer credit from an accredited postsecondary institution with a grade of "C" or better in each of the areas of English, math, and a course which indicates reading ability, i.e. social studies, psychology. c. COMPASS/ASSET placement scores as required by specific program. (First COMPASS/ASSET basic skills assessment is available at each campus location free of charge (\$15 charge for retests.) 5. Submit any additional information required for your chosen program.
