Spring Lake Magnet Center opened in January, 1975 combining the attendance areas of South Lincoln and Hawthorne Elementary Schools. Currently Spring Lake houses about 700 students in pre-kindergarten through fourth grade. Of these, 518 receive free or reduced lunches.

The school serves a diverse community representing a variety of cultural and ethnic backgrounds. 60% of the population is Hispanic, 4% is African American, 2% is Native American, and 2% is Asian/Pacific Islander.

In 2001, Spring Lake became a Math, Spanish and Technology Center.

The district's Dual Language Program compliments our magnet theme and offers students the opportunity to be taught in two languages: English and Spanish.
