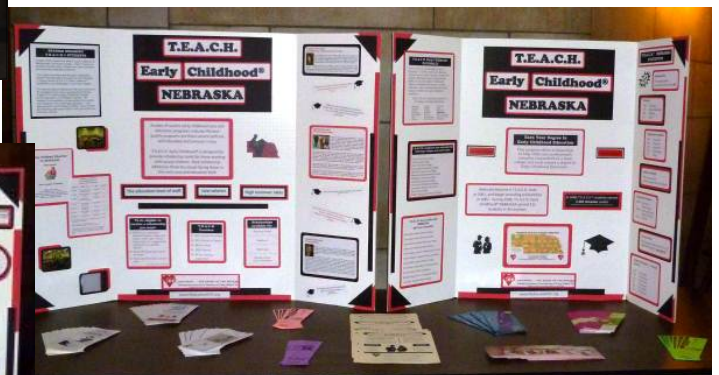


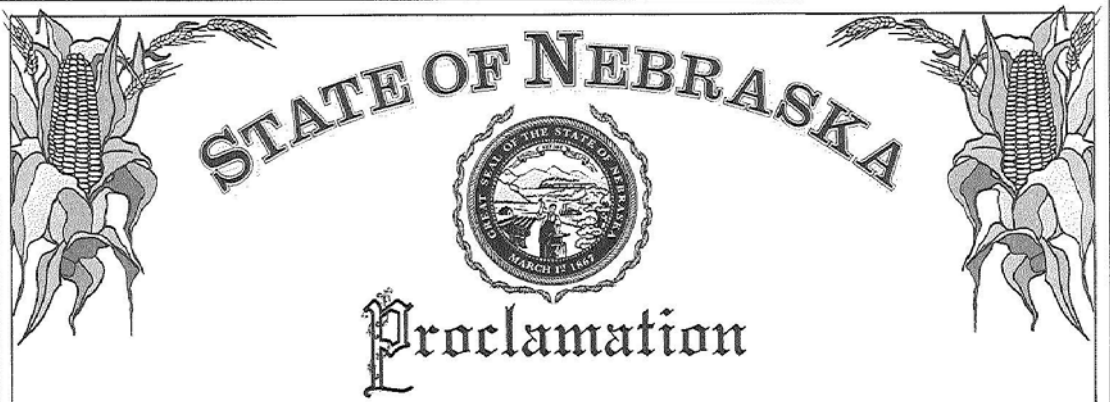

I, Dave Heineman, Governor of the State of Nebraska, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the week of April 10 – 16, 2011, as


