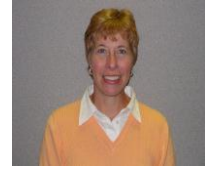


BUILDING FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS

Let's face it, there is no "quick fix" when it comes to guiding children's growth and development yet that is the expectation many parents place on child care providers and teachers when it comes to the care and education of their children. This workshop will focus on the process required to develop a relationship with parents so the "quick fix" is no longer the expectation. Beth will guide participants through realistic expectations one can assume of parents while at the same time honoring the collaborative partnership that must be developed between parent and provider/ teacher. While the format of the workshop focuses on the **4 C's of Relationship Development: Concern---Communication-----Collaboration-----Commitment**, the elements of each area will provide plenty of opportunity for participants to engage in the process. This is not a passive workshop for participants, but rather an opportunity to understand the process by experiencing it. After all, there is no "quick fix" to working with parent's either!
